Bentonville Battlefield State Historic Site offers a teacher institute that allows teachers to earn continuing education credit.

The program lasts two days, covering ten hours of activities designed to engage students as they learn about the Civil War.

Teachers will get the opportunity to speak with staff members about planning field trips, using classroom resources, and facilitating activities. Participants will also get to enjoy these activities themselves.
